Ontario residents with valid OHIP coverage who have both fallopian tubes blocked are insured by OHIP for three (3) In Vitro Fertilization (IVF) cycles over their lifetime. Lab services indicated by an asterix (*) are not covered by OHIP.

Ovarian Stimulation & Insemination for OHIP Insured Patients

Ontario residents with a valid OHIP card who are seeking ovarian stimulation and insemination services will have most fees covered by OHIP. Fees for services not insured by OHIP are outlined below.

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| <input type="checkbox"/> Annual Administration (Block) Fee | 400+H
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- OHIP does not cover all services and expenses that are necessary for a successful Reproductive Medicine Program.

Services covered include: multidisciplinary conference concerning your care with lab scientists, nurses, psychologist and physicians; telephone calls; telephone prescriptions; sick/back to work notes; absent note for federal employees; supplies; education session; scheduling visit with nurse (IVF).

- All 3 cycles must be completed within 1 year.

Donor Sperm

Outreach Health Services (Outreach) is the main distributor of donor sperm for patients of the OFC. Outreach will assist you in selecting a donor, collect fees for units purchased through them, and arrange for delivery of donor units to the OFC. The following fees are collected by the OFC.

We accept patients from outside of Ontario. For these patients, fees are based on the Ontario Medical Association (OMA) rates.

Blood services

The OFC runs 9 hormone tests on site. Fees range between \$15 and \$30 per test.

Drug Dispensary and Hours of Operation

The Ottawa Fertility has an experienced and dedicated pharmacist on site who can respond to questions about fertility medications and how they are administered. The average cost of drugs for one IVF cycle can vary, but is usually between \$3000 - \$5000. Medications can be purchased on site during the hours indicated below. Check with your insurance provider regarding reimbursement for any fertility medications.

Fee and Refund Policy

1. Full payment of fees is due when patients call with their “Day 1” of menses to initiate treatment
2. Payment may be made by Visa, MasterCard, American Express, Interac or cash. Certified cheques must be made payable to the “Ottawa Fertility Centre”
3. All fees are in Canadian Dollars.
4. A no show fee of \$100 may apply for missed appointments. 48 hours’ notice is required to cancel an appointment.
5. Refunds are done by the 8th of the month following treatment
6. Fees may change without advanced notice.

No sperm washing due to cancellation. There is no refund after the first completed cycle.	750 – 1,500
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Cryorenewal (Freezing)

A refund will be given if all material in the freeze is used within 3 months of the renewal date. Fees are due on the renewal date.	300
