



Reversal of Tubal Ligation

For patients who have had their tubes 'tied' (tubal ligation), it may be possible to restore fertility by reconnecting the fallopian tubes. One of the main predictors of pregnancy following this surgery is the original method used to tie the tubes. The reversal surgery is performed under general anaesthesia, through a small bikini-line incision. After an overnight stay in hospital, patients go home the next day.

Please note that for women who have had a prior tubal ligation, the initial consultation and tubal ligation reversal surgery are not covered by OHIP.

Initial Consultation 300

Fees for reverse Tubal Ligation *(Subject to change without notice)*

Surgeon's fee 1,400
(Fees are payable by certified cheque, credit card, debit card or cash, two weeks prior to date of surgery).

Anaesthetist's fee (approximately \$350/hour) 900

Hospital pre-admission appointment 550

Hospital fees (includes HST) 2,628
Certified cheque only, payable to The Ottawa Hospital – Civic Campus. This fee covers a pre-admission visit, operating room expenses and an overnight stay in hospital. Patients go home the morning after surgery. Any additional stay in hospital is charged separately.

Additional stay in hospital is charged separately at \$1,760 per night

Prior to meeting your surgeon for the initial consultation, please arrange for the following:

- Bring a copy of your operative report from your tubal ligation surgery
- Have a semen assessment from your partner
- Get a progesterone blood test done on day 21 of your cycle, or keep a basal body temperature chart for 1-2 months.
